



Seeking High-Impact Research Descriptions from agInnovation Northeast Members

Background

The Association has approved the development of a semiannual publication, **agInnovation Northeast: Impacts**, to highlight selected research projects from each of the Northeast agricultural experiment stations. The Office of the Executive Director will compile station-submitted project profiles into an electronic publication designed to increase organizational awareness among directors and to support future regional collaboration.

Why this matters?

This publication is intended to give directors a practical view “under the hood” of the research being conducted across our regional institutions. By increasing visibility into both mature and emerging projects, the newsletter will help identify shared interests, complementary expertise, and opportunities for collaboration. In addition, the collection of projects will serve as a concise demonstration of the value and outcomes of public investment in Northeast agricultural research.

What we are seeking?

Each station is invited to submit:

- A **three-sentence description of one mature research project** with demonstrable impacts, and **one new research project** with compelling objectives and collaboration potential.
- A **link to the full project description** for each of the two efforts.
- A **high-quality image to accompany each project description**.

Stations may select the projects they believe best demonstrate their work; the newsletter will be drafted from these submissions.
